



Dr. Eric ADJA is the President of the Francophone Agency for Artificial Intelligence ([AFRIA](#)), an international foundation based in Geneva, with the mission of supporting French-speaking countries, particularly African ones, in the promotion of digital technologies and artificial intelligence for business creation and sustainable development.

Previously, he worked as Director of the Digital Francophonie in Paris and Director of the Regional Office for West Africa (Lomé, Togo) of the International Organisation of the Francophonie (OIF).

Dr. ADJA has also held the positions of Director of the international NGO "Innovations and Networks for Development (Innovations et Réseaux pour le Développement (IRED))" in Geneva, Advisor to the President of the Republic of Benin (Cotonou), Professor at the University of Abomey-Calavi, Associate Researcher at the CNRS (Villejuif, France) and Acting Director General of the International Observatory on Migrant Remittances (New-York).

He holds a PhD in Linguistics and Computer Science from the University of Paris 7 Denis Diderot, a DES from the University of Geneva, a DEA in Scientific and Technical Information from the University of Marne-la-Vallée and a Master's degree in International Economics and Globalisation from the University Pierre Mendès France in Grenoble. He is also a former scholarship holder of the Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie (AUF), at the Catholic University of Leuven in Belgium.
